#### Number

Make a Shape Collage Draw different 2D shapes to make a picture. Colour in your picture. Try to use a different colour for every shape so all the shapes show up clearly.

2D Shape Flashcards Look at the 2D Shape Flashcards sheet. Make a set of your own 2D shape flashcards. Use your cards to learn the names of the shapes. Teach other family members the names of your shapes.

2D Shape Hunt Go on a shape hunt around your house. how many 2D shapes you can find? You could also look for shapes when you are outdoors. You could record these in your jotter.
