For your spelling activity for this week have a go at playing the game Stop the Bus. You can play this game alone or play against someone in your home. Have a look at the example table below.

The aim of the game is to come up with a name, an animal, a food/drink and a country/city for each of the letters of a word. The table shows an example with a word from all three spelling groups.

If you are playing against somebody then decide what word you are going to do and it is a race to see who can complete the table first. If you are playing alone then time yourself to see how long it takes you to complete a word.

You can use the same answer more than once as long as it is in a different spelling word. For example, I have used iguana as my animal for the word 'sir' and for the word 'eight'. However you can't use it twice in the same spelling word.
