P3 Teachers

Task 1- Numbers to 1000- place value, ordering –PPM32 and PPM12.

Remember-

Thousands Th	Hundreds H	Tens T	Units U

PPM32- Write the numbers in order from smallest to largest. For another challenge, ask someone at home to write some 2 digit numbers on pieces of paper- sort these into order.

PPM12- Look carefully at the place value. Combine the hundreds, tens and units to make the number.

Task 2- Addition and Subtraction- PPM69 and PPM81

PPM69- Use the function machine. Add the numbers shown inside the robots to each number in the table. You can do this mentally or use a written vertical addition (chimney sum). If you are using vertical addition, remember to add the units first and then the tens.

81- Split each number into hundreds, tens and units. Add up each column before putting the hundreds, tens and units back together again to find the total.

Task 3- Measure- PPM212 and Challenge Cards

PPM212- If you are able to print the worksheet off then please use a ruler to carefully measure and record the answers in the table. If you can't print, don't worry! Ask someone at home to draw some different sized lines on paper. You can then measure and make your own table.

Measuring length challenge cards- Have a look and try some of the measuring activities on the cards.
