

P3 Week 10- Revision Notes

Hi P3,

Here are some notes which you might find useful when completing your tasks. You'll also find games on HA and Sumdog. We appreciate it might be tricky to remember things you worked on at the start of P3. If there's anything you're not sure about, remember you can email us for help or extra work.

P3 Teachers

Task 1- Money –PPM266, PPM270 and PPM272.

- PPM266- Count and write the total for each set of coins. Ask someone at home if they have some loose change- count the coins. How much do they have? Remember to wash your hands after handling the coins!
 - PPM270- List the coins to make each total. Remember £1 = 100p.
 - PPM272- Try to solve these money word problems. You could do a written sum or work out mentally.
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Task 2- Area – PPM220

- PPM220- Count the squares to find the total area in each shape. Fill in the table or write the amount on paper. Remember to record area in square cm. To find the perimeter, you count around the outside of each shape.

Example:



Area: 2cm^2 Perimeter: 6cm

Task 3- Weight- PPM216 and Weight

- PPM216- Ask someone at home to borrow scales. Find objects around your house to estimate and then weigh.

If you don't have scales, don't worry, just miss this task out. You can complete the HA and Sumdog activities on weight instead.

- Weight worksheet- add to find the total weights.
