Task 1- Angle –PPM255 and Right Angles

PPM255 and Right angles- These activity sheets are designed to help you practise finding quarter turns and right angles. Either print off to complete or talk through the sheets with someone at home. If you can't print, why not take a piece of paper and go on a hunt around your house to find right angles? The corner of your paper is a right angle. Match it up against objects. Record what you find.

Task 2- Pattern – PPM245 and PPM246
