Detective Who What Where Why

Study the picture in the document. Do you find anything strange about it? Put on your detective hat and start questioning. For example, 'Why is the cat in the bird cage?' How many questions can you come up with? Your questions must start with either who/what/where or why. Why questions will be probably be the more obvious, so start with them then move onto the more challenging who, what and where.

Answer the 4 questions making sure you use full sentences when you do.

Snapshot Mat
