The main focus for learning and teaching this term will be:

Languages and Literacy

- * Writing - variety of activities developing functional and imaginative writing using PM writing targets.
- * Using class novel, pupils will be introduced to P6 Literature Circle roles and reflective reading tasks. This will include developing comprehension skills, and finding key information within texts.
- * A variety of spelling activities will be undertaken in class.
- * French 6a - pupils to revise greetings, sharing personal information and weather.
- * Spanish 6b - introduction to Spanish language - greetings, personal information and numbers.

Maths and Numeracy

- * Developing strategies and confidence for mental calculations - through number talks.
- * Heinemann Active Maths - differentiated by task and level, looking at fractions, decimals and percentages.
- * Time.
- * Develop an understanding of the application of mathematics in real life situations.

Health and Wellbeing

- * PE -focus on fitness - once with Mrs Keery, once with class teacher.
- * Daily Mile

Interdisciplinary learning

- * Darwin and Biodiversity - the story of Charles Darwin and significance of the theory of evolution. Biodiversity and adaptation.

Discrete subjects

- * Environmental art including sketches and collages - linking to Darwin.

- * Science - looking at scientific language and investigating ecosystems, plant adaptations and other genetics activities.
- * Music and drama - music appreciation (Covid-19 rules restrict singing and sharing equipment).
